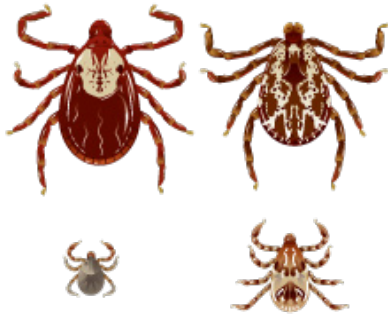


# Health risks associated with common tick species

Different tick species can make you sick in many ways from spreading germs and causing allergies to blood loss and even paralysis.

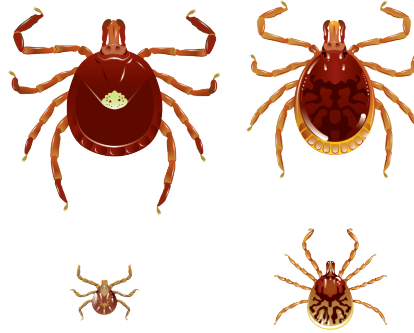
**Ticks can do many things with one bite.**

## New York ticks and their potential health risks



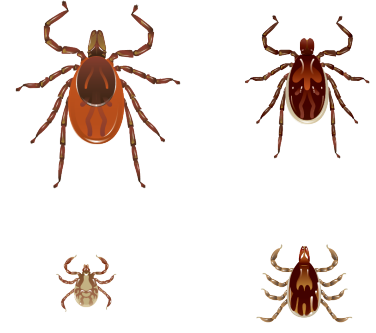
### American Dog (Wood) Tick

- Powassan virus



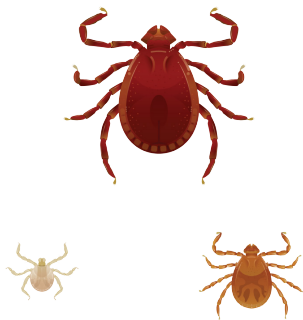
### Lone-Star Tick

- Bourbon virus
- Spotted rickettsia
- STARI
- Tick Paralysis
- Tularemia
- Heartland virus
- Powassan virus
- Alpha-gal allergy



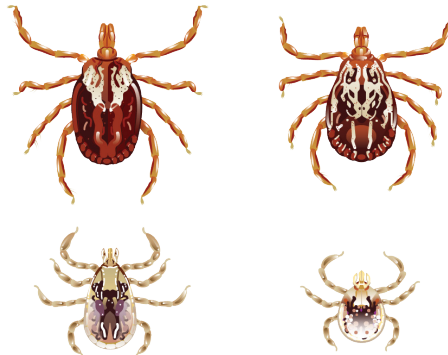
### Blacklegged (Deer) Tick

- Lyme Disease
- Babesiosis
- Tick Paralysis
- *Borrelia miyamotoi*
- Anaplasmosis
- Powassan Virus
- Ehrlichiosis



### Longhorned Tick

- Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever
- Theileria orientalis
- Severe blood loss
- Heartland virus
- Powassan virus
- Tick Paralysis



### Gulf Coast Tick
